

Students enrolled in Fall 2022 lessons are contracted for 14 lessons beginning the week of August 22 through the week of December 12. Lessons are located at the Pathfinder Church Ministry Center on the 2nd floor. If you drive to the Pathfinder Campus and turn onto the west parking lot (between the church and Einstein’s), follow the signs to the Ministry Center. Enter through the Ministry Center Door and take the elevator to the second floor. Exit the elevator and your instructor will be there to greet you and help you find your room.

PAYMENT


- Lessons are \$28 per 30 minute lesson. Fall and spring sessions are 14 lessons over 17 weeks (\$392 total tuition). Payment for lessons can be paid in full or partial monthly payments. If you opt to pay in full on the registration form, you will be invoiced one time at the beginning of the session (September 5) and complete your payment through Paypal. If you’ve opted to pay monthly payments, your will be billed monthly via auto-pay on the 5th of September, October, November and December to complete 4 monthly payments.
- *In the event the student chooses to stop lessons prior to the end of the session, they will be obligated to pay 75% of the remaining tuition in the session. There is no refund for lessons already completed.*

EXPECTATIONS

- Students must sign in upon arrival for their lesson at School of the Arts to ensure our records are accurate and all students are accounted for in the building.
- A lesson will not be extended if a student is late and if the student is over 15 minutes late the lesson will be cancelled.

ABSENCE/CANCELLATIONS

- Any absence without a **24-hour notice** to the instructor qualifies as an “unexcused absence” and the student will be charged for a full lesson, regardless of illness, COVID-19, or circumstance.
- If a student knows they will be absent for their lesson more than 24 hours in advance, it is the student’s responsibility to either cancel their lesson in the portal, or communicate with the instructor ahead of time. To cancel a lesson in the portal, select the lesson in the calendar and click “Cancel Attendance.” It is also vital that you notify your instructor of this cancellation immediately.



- It is the student’s responsibility to make sure they complete all of their lessons during the session. If a lesson is missed due to a student’s “excused absence” the instructor will make reasonable effort to reschedule the lesson based upon their schedule within the remaining buffer weeks. If the lesson cannot be made up, the student is NOT entitled to a refund and the lesson will not be carried over into the next session.

INSTRUCTOR

- The student may request a different instructor at any time. School of the Arts reserves the right to reassign a student to a different instructor in exceptional circumstances.
- Each instructor has been screened by Pathfinder School of the Arts, but parents/guardians have the option of being in the room with their child during the lesson.
- School of the Arts is not responsible for students or children left unattended either before or after the lesson.
