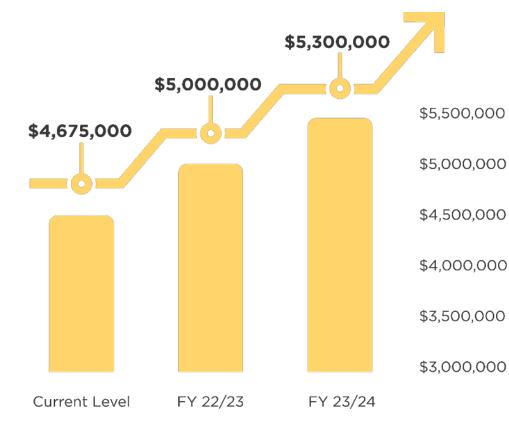

- ✦Paycheck Protection Program Income (PPP) of \$805
  - Expenses were in FY19/20
  - Use PPP Income over two fiscal years to assist with uncertainty
  - This is the second and final year

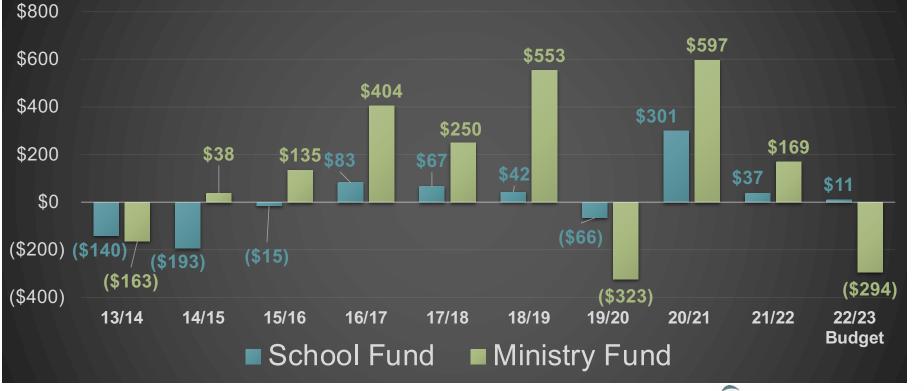

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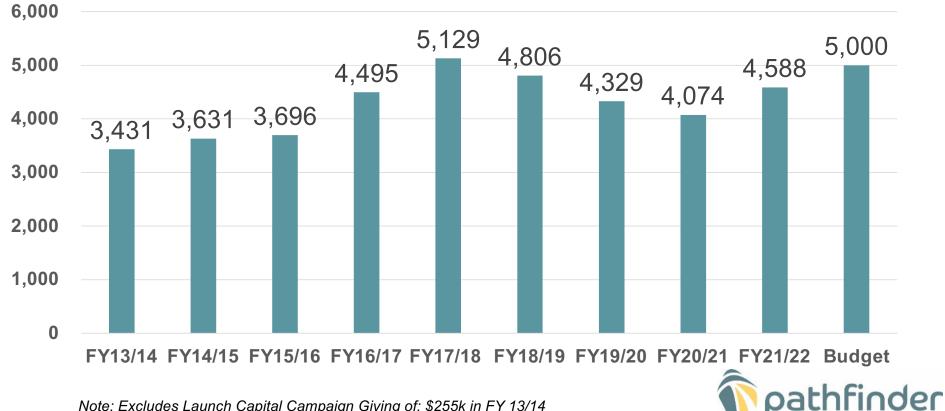

## **Congregation Approved Debt**

May 2021 approved up to \$1,500,000 of additional debt for capital infrastructure expenditures, with the financing of all outstanding debt to be extended to 10 years.

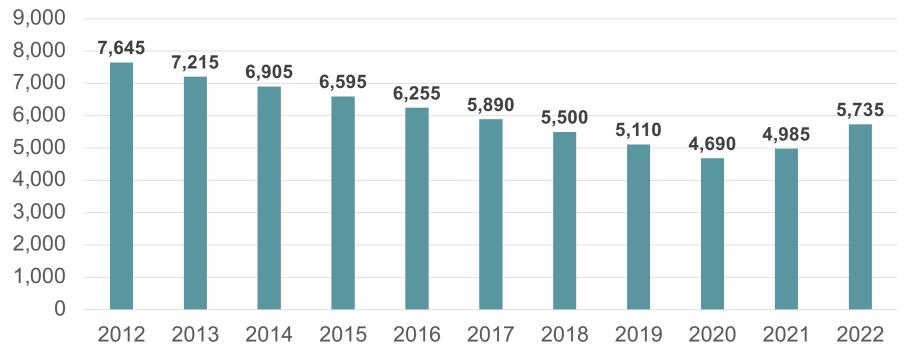
#### Debt

December 2021 refinanced our debt taking on additional \$750,000 with option to draw up to the \$1,500,000.

We anticipate taking the additional draw of \$750,000 in November 2022.



## **Debt Outstanding**



Balances are as of December 31<sup>st</sup> each year. Congregation approved up to \$1,500,000 of additional debt for infrastructure in May 2021. Payment of \$485,000 will be made January 2023
