JOB DESCRIPTION:

At Pathfinder School of the Arts, our goal is to teach music and nurture talent in students of all ages and abilities, while promoting a lifelong enjoyment and love for music. We emphasize creative learning strategies and encourage students to learn all styles of music from classical to contemporary. Instructors and residents are expected to tailor lessons according to each individual student. There is not a required curriculum that School of the Arts provides or requires. School of the Arts provides all students to instructors and schedules lessons in 3 sessions yearly: Fall, Spring, and Summer. Each Fall and Spring session, the instructor will teach 15, 30-minute lessons.

Summer Session residency is based on invitation.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Teach 30-minute, weekly lessons utilizing standard curriculums and methods
- Communicate with students and parents before and during each session
- Keep weekly attendance and lesson notes
- Prepare students for recitals as well as attend recitals
- Coordinate and pioneer 1 special workshop per academic year
- Perform in Pathfinder weekend worship services twice monthly
- Perform and assist with Next Gen worship once monthly

QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE:

- Some higher education in emphasized instrument or expertise
- Prior teaching experience preferred
- Formal training or education required
- Experience with contemporary music styles preferred

WORK SCHEDULE:

- Private Lessons are flexible to applicant's schedule. School of the Arts is open M-Th from 3-8pm. Residents are expected to teach a minimum of 6 weekly private lessons
- Weekend services/rehearsals are Saturdays 3:00pm-6:30pm, and Sundays 8am – 12:30pm
Wednesday services/rehearsals are 4:00-8:00

COMPENSATION:

This is a contract, 1099 position. On average, a resident will work at Pathfinder for 10 hrs. each week. Residents will be compensated for lessons separate from their other performing responsibilities which will be paid by stipend. Specifics to be reviewed upon final interview.
