- 1. We can understand how people, even organizations, could have different sets of values that are most important to them. Why is it challenging to respect differences in faith/biblical values in other Christians?
- 2. Dion Garrett argued that as Christians, many of our disagreements over biblical values & morality are disagreements about the <u>order and priority</u> we assign to biblical values, not a dispute on which values are biblical themselves. Do you agree or disagree? Try to apply his theory to a relevant hot-button example.
- 3. Dion Garrett also said that it's impossible for any *one* of us to embrace and live out all of God's values perfectly, but maybe together, *we* can. What do you think he meant by that? *(for help, see Romans 12:3-8)*
- 4. Why do you think you find yourself treating other Christians, who prioritize different values, as heretics rather than complements you desperately need?
- 5. Read Ecclesiastes 3:1-11. How can this help counsel us as we seek to live out the whole gambit of the bible's values individually or as a congregation?
