TITLE: Multi-Instrumentalist Instructor

JOB DESCRIPTION:

At Pathfinder School of the Arts, our goal is to teach music and nurture talent in students of all ages and abilities, while promoting a lifelong enjoyment and love for music. We emphasize creative learning strategies and encourage students to learn contemporary styles of vocal music, including worship, pop, country, musical theater, and singer-songwriter. The instructor is expected to tailor the lesson according to the student's musical interests and goals, but there is no required curriculum that the School of the Arts provides or expects the instructor to teach. School of the Arts provides all students to instructors and schedules lessons in 3 sessions: Fall, Spring, and Summer. Each Fall and Spring session, the instructor will teach 14 30-minute lessons. During the summer session, the instructor will teach 8 30-minute lessons.
